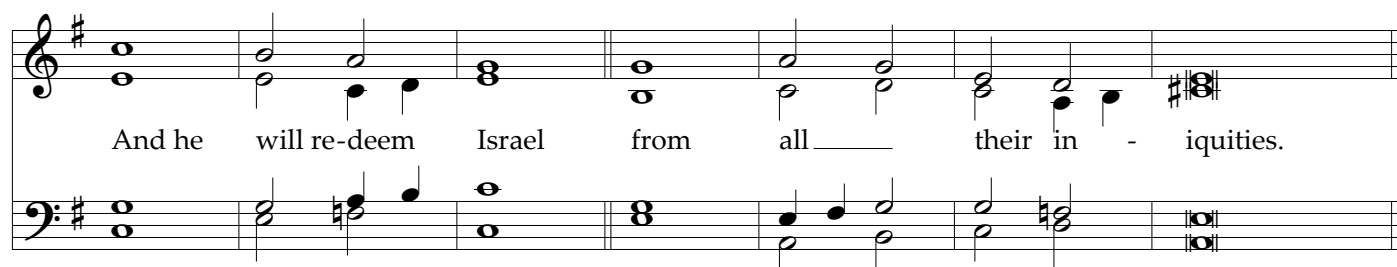
I trust the LORD; my soul trusts in his word.
