2. Gloria tibi, Christe, Sapientia Dei Patris. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Wisdom of God the Father."]
3. Gloria tibi, Christe, Verbum Dei. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Word of God."]
4. Gloria tibi, Domine, Fili Dei vivi. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Son of the Living God"—Cf. Matthew 16:16]
5. Laus et honor tibi, Domine Iesu. [Paul Ford's translation: "Praise and honor to you, Lord Jesus."]
6. Laus tibi, Christe, Rex aeternae gloriae. [Paul Ford's translation: "Praise to you, O Christ, King of Eternal Glory."]
7. Magna et mirabilia opera tua, Domine. [Paul Ford's translation: "Great and wonderful are your works, O Lord"—Cf. Revelation 15:3]
8. Salus et gloria et virtus Domino Iesu Christo. [Paul Ford's translation: "Salvation and glory and power to the Lord Jesus Christ"—Cf. Revelation 19:1]
