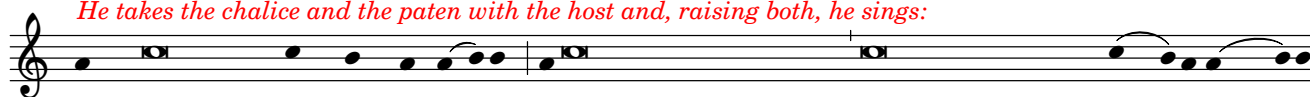
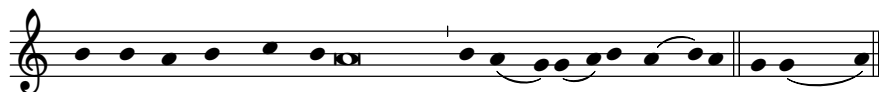


Doxology

He takes the chalice and the paten with the host and, raising both, he sings:



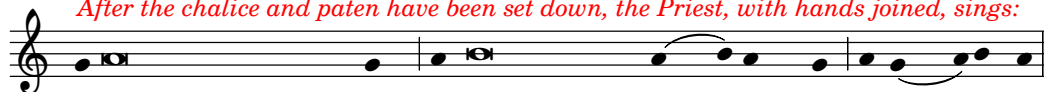
Through him, and with him and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Ho- ly Spir- it,



all glo- ry and hon- or is yours for ev- er and ev- er. **A- men.**

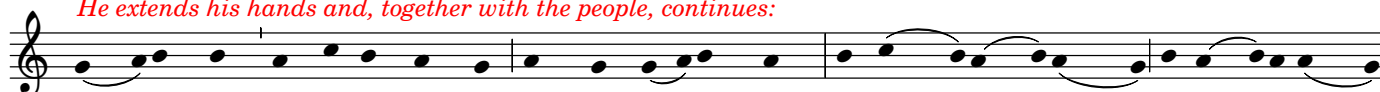
Communion Rite

Our Fa- ther, who art in heav- en, hal- lowed be thy name; they king- dom come, thy will be done

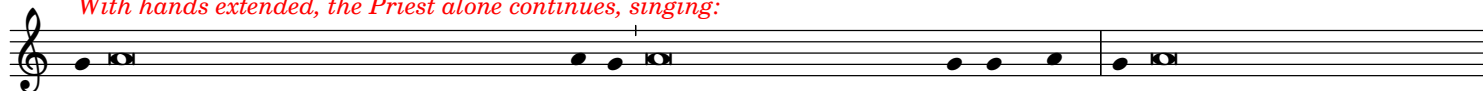


on earth as it is in heav- en. Give us this day our dai- ly bread, and for- give us our tres- pass- es,

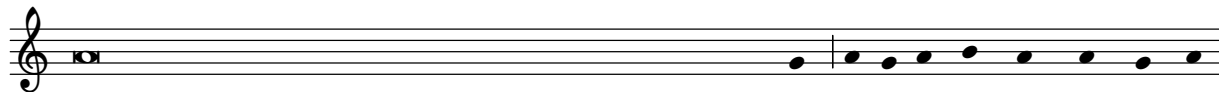


as we for- give those who tre- pass a- gainst us; and lead up not in- to temp- ta- tion, but de- liv- er us from e- vil.
