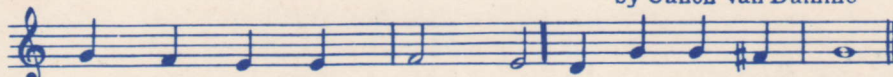

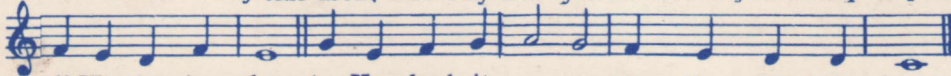
Melody of "Adoro te" as given
