1. Gloria et laus tibi, Christe. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory and praise to you, O Christ."] US Lectionary #223.1: "Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!"
2. Gloria tibi, Christe, Sapientia Dei Patris. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Wisdom of God the Father."] US Lectionary #223.2: "Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ, Wisdom of God the Father!"
3. Gloria tibi, Christe, Verbum Dei. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Word of God."] US Lectionary #223.3: "Glory to you, Word of God, Lord Jesus Christ!"
4. Gloria tibi, Domine, Fili Dei vivi. [Paul Ford's translation: "Glory to you, O Christ, Son of the Living God"—Cf. Matthew 16:16] US Lectionary #223.4: "Glory to you, Lord Jesus Christ, Son of the living God!"
5. Laus et honor tibi, Domine Iesu. [Paul Ford's translation: "Praise and honor to you, Lord Jesus."] US Lectionary #223.5: "Praise and honor to you, Lord Jesus Christ!"
6. Laus tibi, Christe, Rex aeternae gloriae. [Paul Ford's translation: "Praise to you, O Christ, King of eternal glory."] US Lectionary #223.6: "Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!"
7. Magna et mirabilia opera tua, Domine. [Paul Ford's translation: "Great and wonderful are your works, O Lord"—Cf. Revelation 15:3] US Lectionary #223.7: "Marvelous and great are your works, O Lord!"
8. Salus et gloria et virtus Domino Iesu Christo. [Paul Ford's translation: "Salvation and glory and power to the Lord Jesus Christ"—Cf. Revelation 19:1] US Lectionary #223.8: "Salvation, glory, and power to the Lord Jesus Christ!"
