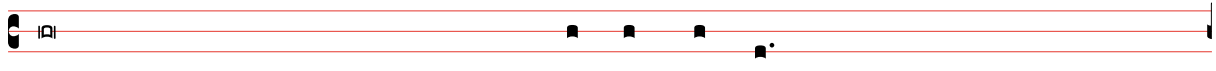
✠ ON the last and greatest day of the festival,

'If any man is thirsty, let him come to me!



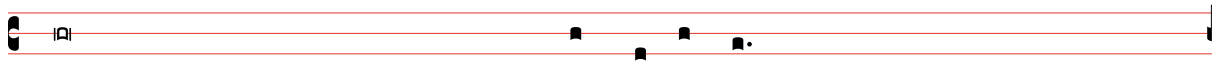
Let the man come and drink who believes in me!'
