

[The nations] shall revere your name, /O LORD, and all the kings of the /earth your glory, When the LORD has rebuilt /Zion and appeared /in his glory; When he has regarded the prayer of the /destitute, and not de-/-spised their prayer. R.

Let this be written for the genera-/-tion to come, and let his future crea-/-tures praise the **Lord**: "The LORD looked down from his /holy height, from heaven he /beheld the earth,
To hear the groaning of the /prisoners, to release /those **doomed** to die." R.

The children of your servants /shall abide, and their posterity shall continue /in **your** presence. That the name of the LORD may be declared /in Zion; and his praise, /in Jerusalem, When the peoples gather /together, and the kingdoms, /to **serve** the LORD. R.
