Were You There, sung by the HTS schola, is an arrangement of the spiritual by the composer Noel Goemanne. In 1952, Goemanne and his wife Janine immigrated to the United States, from Belgium, and he took the position of church organist at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Victoria, Tx. For many years, Mr. Goemanne was the music director here at Holy Trinity Seminary. In 1977 Pope Paul VI awarded him the Pro Ecclesia Medal and in 1980 he received the Degree of Doctor of Sacred Music, *Honoris Causa*, from St. Joseph's College, Rensselaer, Indiana. 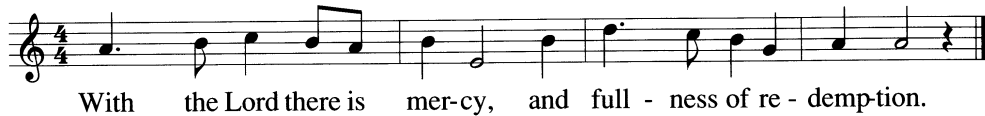

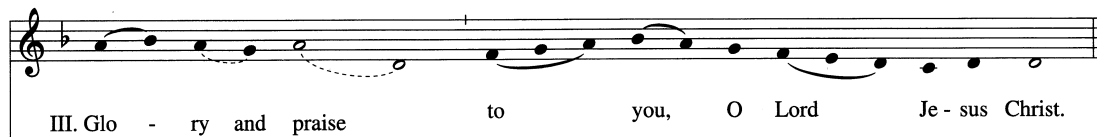
