


Communion Antiphon

Chanted at the end of Mass, before the Recessional Hymn



He guides me in right paths for His name's sake. Even though I walk in the dark valley I fear no evil; for You are at my side with Your rod and Your staff that give me courage.


You spread the table before me in the sight of my foes; You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.

Gospel Acclamation


A responsorial setting of a traditional ‘Tract’ will be sung as our Gospel Acclamation. This is identical in format to the Responsorial Psalm.
