- 10 I <u>have</u> been young, and now am old, † yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken * or their children <u>begging bread</u>.




Wealth and riches are in théir houses, * and their righteousness endures <u>fòr</u>ever.


- 2 May he send you help from the sánctuary, * and give you support from Zìon.

- Now I know that the LORD will help his anointed; 'he will answer him from his holy héaven * with mighty victories by his rìght hand.




