Vocalists seeking a Catholic choir dedicated to excellent liturgical music—especially plainsong, Gregorian chant, and classical polyphony—are invited to join this newly-formed ensemble.

The choir sings Evensong (the traditional-language Anglican Use, Roman Catholic service combining Vespers and Compline) each Sunday at 4:30 pm, preceded by a rehearsal at 3:45 pm.

Singers need general music-reading skills, some choral experience, and a blending voice, as well as a cooperative spirit and reliability.

Founded in 1842, Mount Calvary Church entered the Roman Catholic Church as an Anglican Use parish on January 22, 2012, in accord with the Apostolic Constitution *Anglicanorum Coetibus* of Pope Benedict XVI. Its services are Roman Catholic liturgies and its Sunday Masses satisfy the Catholic Mass obligation. The choirmaster is an experienced Catholic musician with deep Anglican roots.
