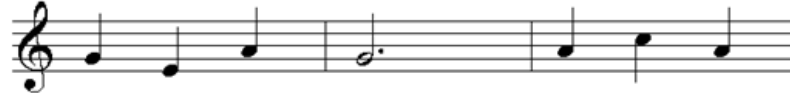

PROFESSION OF FAITH *Nicene Creed*

Join us for Mark Husey's farewell reception in Neglia Hall

Raised in Harford County, Maryland, Mark Husey's seminal experiences in sacred music were singing in the choir of Emmanuel Episcopal Church in Bel Air in 1982 and playing for Mass at Saint John the Evangelist Church in Long Green Valley in 1984. He received the Bachelor of Music degree from Westminster Choir College (Princeton, New Jersey) in 1991, singing with The Westminster Choir in Spoleto Festivals in Charleston and Italy for two summers, returning for a third as their accompanist and tenor soloist. Subsequent performances in Piccolo Spoleto as organist and conductor of the Choir of Saint John's Episcopal Church in Baltimore brought him back to Charleston in the 1990's. Confirmed Roman Catholic in 1999 at the Church of the Nativity (Timonium), he received Master of Arts in Pastoral Liturgy and Music from Saint Joseph's College (Rensselaer, Indiana) in 2004 while serving parishes in Atlanta and Miami. Husey came to Saint Peter's January 2006: he initiated the choral scholar program that fall with Dr. Bill and Dianne Neglia, established Capella Pueri to sing Fauré's *Requiem* with members of the of the SC Philharmonic on All Souls' Day 2008, and created the parish YouTube account in 2009. [YouTube.com/VisitStPeters](https://www.youtube.com/VisitStPeters) records a diverse palette of sacred choral and congregational literature including Monteverdi's *Vespers of 1610*, Bach's *Mass in B minor*, and several regional and online premiers. Husey offers his profound thanks to Saint Peter's and the greater Columbia community for ten years of collaboration in ministry and music, in addition to many thanks to the excellent priests and deacons of the Diocese of Charleston.
