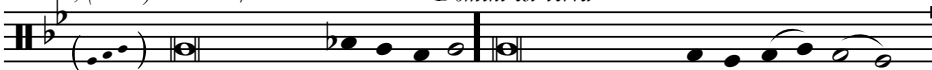

Such is the race/that seeks for him,

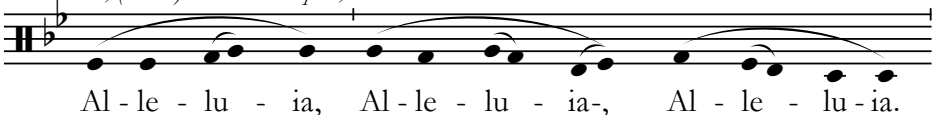
that seeks the face of the/God of **Jacob. R.**
