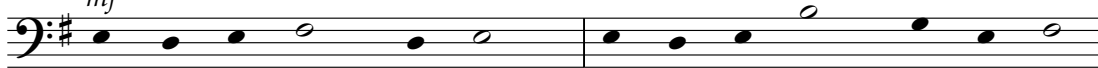

1. Bow down your ear, O Lord, and answer me, for I am poor and in misery.



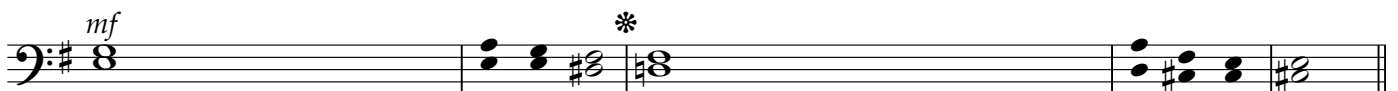
2. Keep watch over my life, for I am faithful; save your servant who puts his trust in you.
