







1. Come let us sing to the Lord; let us shout for joy to the Rock of our sal - va - tion.




2. Let us come before his presence with thanks - giv - ing




and raise a loud shout to him with psalms.




3. For the Lord is a great God, and a great King a - bove all gods.




4. In his hands are the caverns of the earth, and the heights of the hills are his al - so.



5. The sea is his, for he made it, and his hands have molded the dry land.



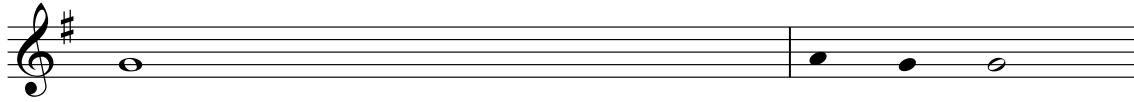
6. Come, let us bow down, and bend the knee, and kneel before the Lord our Ma - ker.



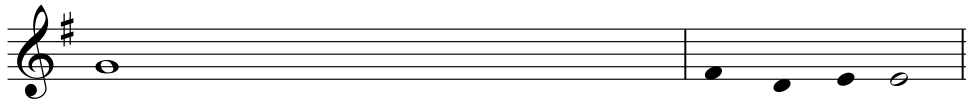
7. For he is our God, and we are the people of his pasture and the sheep of his hand.



Oh, that today you would hear - ken to his voice!



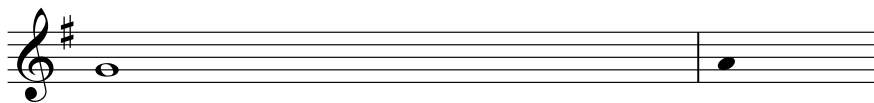
8. Harden not your hearts, as your forebears did in the wild - er - ness,



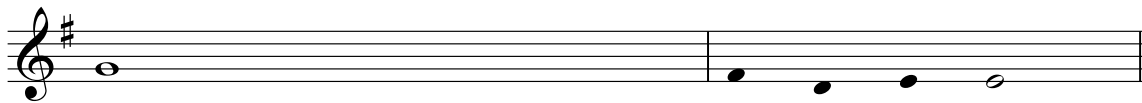
at Meribah, and on that day at Massah, when they temp-ted me.



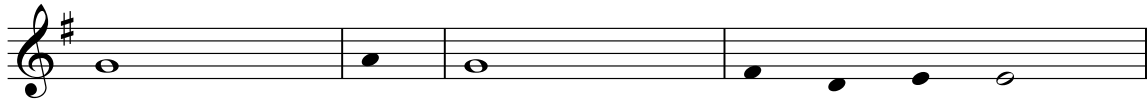
9. They put me to the test, though they had seen my works.
