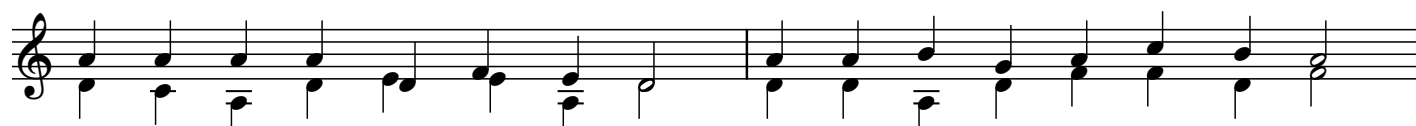

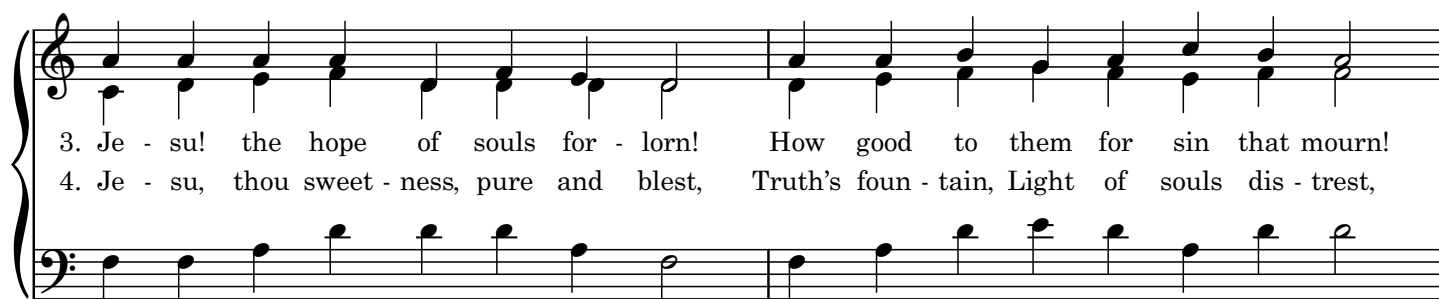

2. No word is sung more sweet than this: No name is heard more full of bliss:



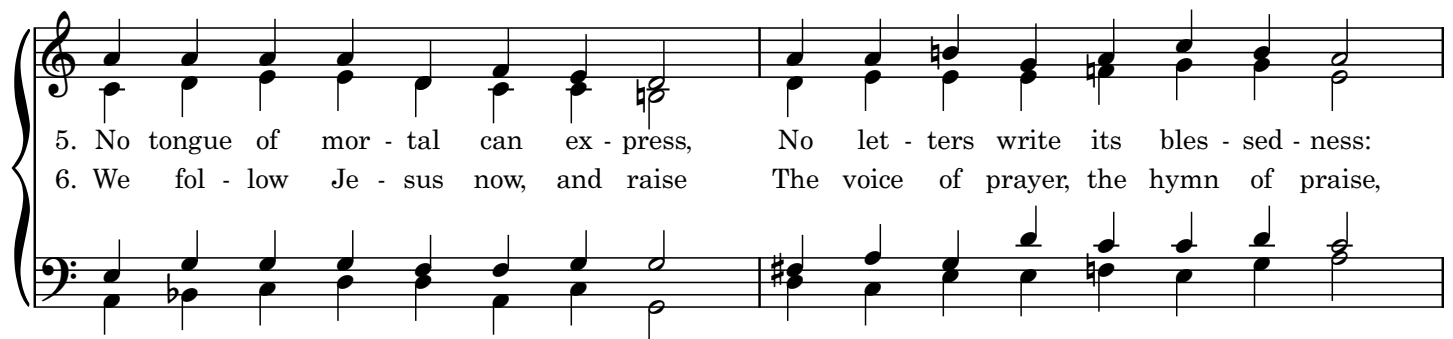

No thought brings sweet - er com - fort nigh,_____ Than Je - sus, Son of God most high.



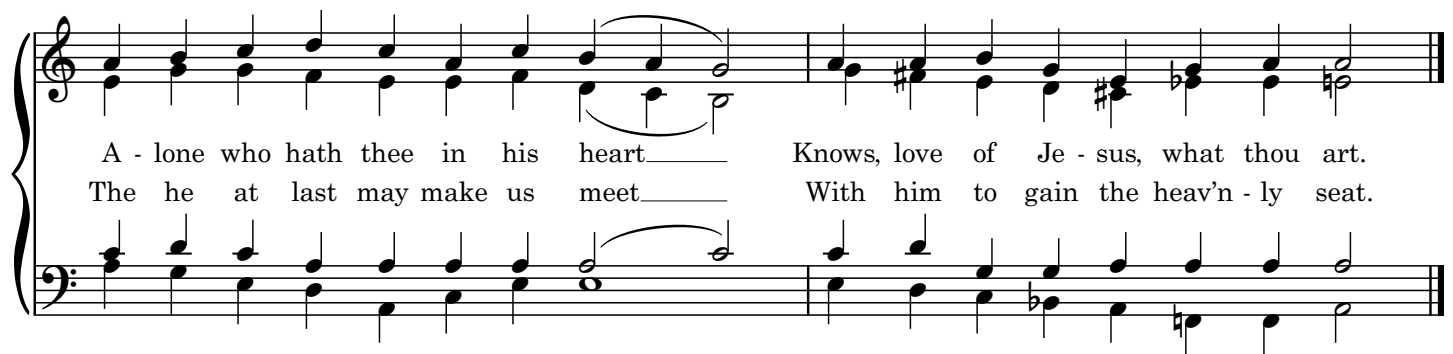
