



Ash Wednesday

Tract: *Psalm 103:10; 79:8-9* TONE VIII


Verses:  
O Lord, deal not with us after our sins:  
nor reward us according to our wickednesses.  
Lord, remember not our old sins, but have mercy upon us, and that soon:  
for we are come to great misery. [Here genuflect]  
Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of thy Name, O Lord:  
O deliver us and be merciful unto our sins, for thy Name’s sake.

Gradual: *Psalm 91:11-12* TONE V

Antiphon:





Verses:  
He shall give his Angels charge over thee:  
to keep thee in all thy ways.  
They shall bear thee in their hands:  
that thou hurt not thy foot against a stone. *(Repeat Antiphon)*

Tract: *Psalm 91:1-2, 15-16* TONE VIII

Verses:  
Whoso dwelleth under the defence of the Most High:  
shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.  
I will say unto the Lord, Thou art my hope and my stronghold:  
my God, in him will I trust.  
He shall call upon me, and I will hear him: yea, I am with him in trouble.  
I will deliver him, and bring him to honour:  
with long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

Tract: *Ps 91:1-7, 11-16* TONE VIII


Verses:  
Whoso dwelleth under the defence of the Most High:  
shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.  
I will say unto the Lord, Thou art my hope and my stronghold:  
my God, in him will I trust.  
For he shall deliver thee from the snare of the hunter:  
And from the noisome pestilence.  
He shall defend thee under his wings:  
and thou shalt be safe under his feathers.  
His faithfulness and truth shall be thy shield and buckler:  
thou shalt not be afraid for any terror by night.  
Nor for the arrow that flieth by day; for the pestilence that walketh in darkness:  
nor for the sickness that destroyeth in the noon-day.  
A thousand shall fall beside thee, and ten thousand at thy right hand:

Tract: *Psalm 60:2, 4b , 5* TONE VIII


Verses:

Verses:  
Unto thee lift I up mine eyes: O thou that dwellest in the heavens.  
Behold, even as the eyes of servants: look unto the hand of their masters.  
And as the eyes of a maiden: unto the hand of her mistress.  
Even so our eyes wait upon the Lord our God: until he have mercy upon us.  
Have mercy upon us, O Lord: have mercy upon us.

Many a time have they fought against me: from my youth up.  
May Israel now say: Yea, many a time have they vexed me from my youth up.  
But they have not prevailed against me: the ploughers ploughed upon my back.  
And made long furrows:  
but the righteous Lord hath hewn the snares of the ungodly in pieces.

Palm Sunday

TONE VIII

Tract I: *Ps 22: 1-8, 17b, 18, 21, 23, 31, 32*

*Verses:*

My God, my God, look upon me: why hast thou forsaken me,  
and art so far from my health and from the words of my complaint?  
O my God, I cry in the day-time, but thou hearest not:  
and in the night season also I take no rest.  
And thou continuest holy: O thou worship of Israel.  
Our fathers hoped in thee: they trusted in thee, and thou didst deliver them.  
They called upon thee, and were holpen:  
they put their trust in thee, and were not confounded.  
But as for me, I am a worm, and no man:  
a very scorn of men, and the outcast of the people.  
All they that see me laugh me to scorn:  
they shoot out their lips, and shake their heads, saying,  
He trusted in God, that he would deliver him:  
let him deliver him, if he will have him.

TONE VIII

*Verses:*

From the rising up of the sun, unto the going down of the same:  
my Name shall be great among the Gentiles.  
And in every place incense shall be offered unto my Name: and a pure offering.  
Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine: which I have mingled.
