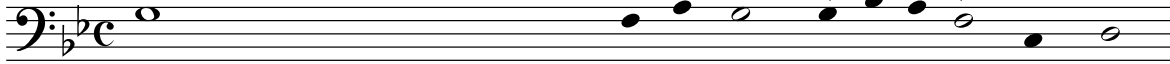

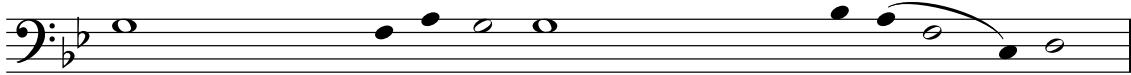

let your ears con - sider well the voice of my sup - pli - ca - tion.



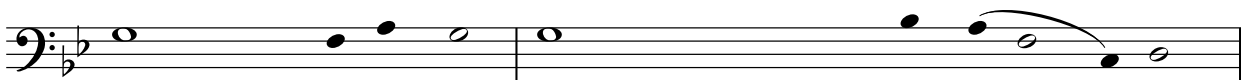
2. If you, Lord, were to note what is done a miss, * O Lord, who could stand?



3. For there is forgive - ness with you; * therefore you shall be feared.



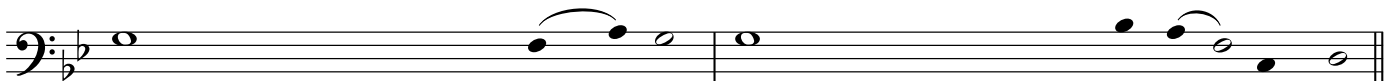
4. I wait for the Lord; my soul waits for him; * in his word is my hope.



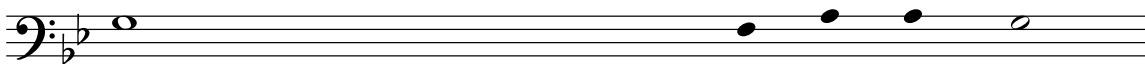

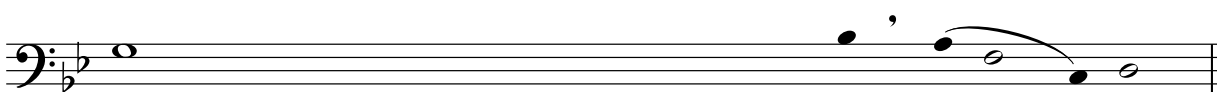
6. O Israel, wait for the Lord, * for with the Lord there is mer - cy;
