For the Invitatory today, only the versicle by the Celebrant (“O Lord, open...”) and the response by the congregation (“and my mouth...”) will be prayed. As provided for in the rubrics, the Invitatory Psalm will be omitted, and the Hymn will begin right away.

Note that the Morning Prayer psalm and the antiphons for Ash Wednesday are taken from Friday, Week III. The rest of Morning Prayer is proper to Ash Wednesday.
