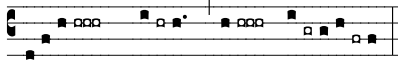
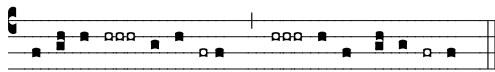


Canticle of Zechariah Tone V



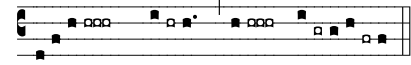
1. **B**lessèd ✠ be the Lord, the God of **Israel**; * he has come to his **people** and **set** them free.

Canticle of Mary Tone VI



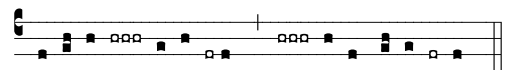
1. **M**y Soul ✠ proclaims the *greatness* of the Lord, * my spirit rejoices in *God* my **Savior**
