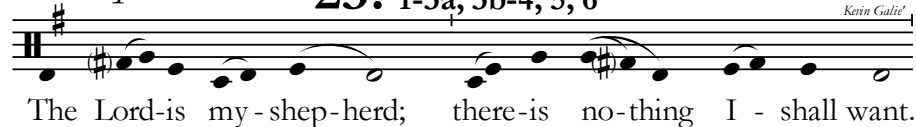


# ALL SOULS

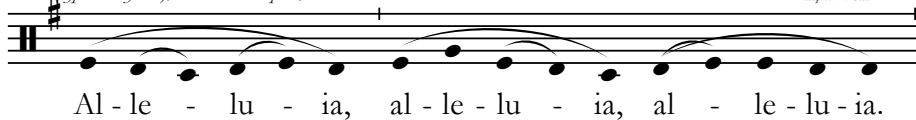
