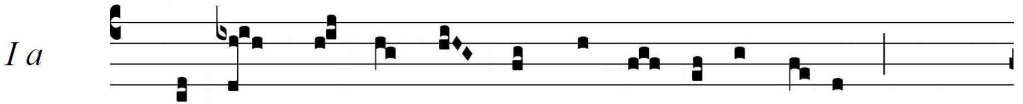

*Ps 109 (110): 1-5, 7*

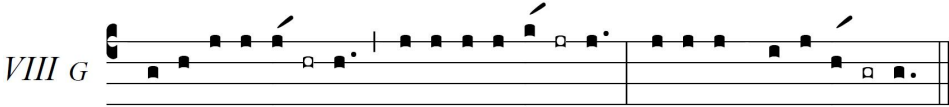


1. The Lord's revelation to my Mas-ter: †

world **with**-out end. Amen

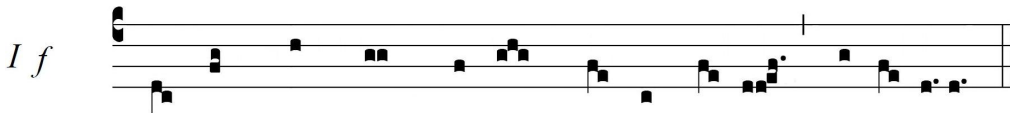


*Ant. 2* The earth trem-bled be-fore the Lord, al-le-lu-ia.

*Ps 113A (114): 1-8*

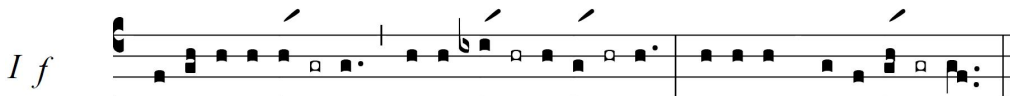


1. When Israel came forth from *E*-gypt, \*
