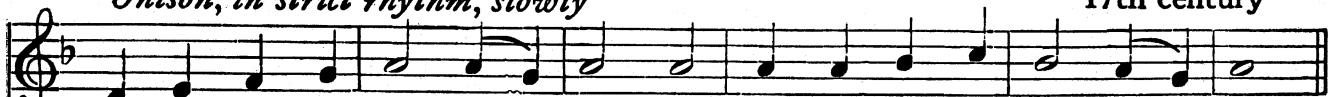
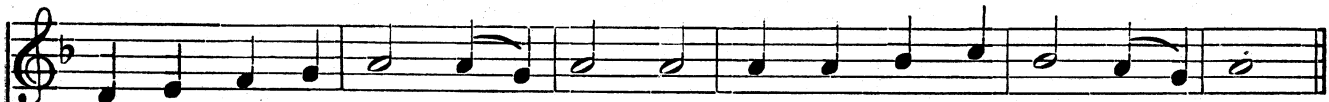


PICARDY
