

## The Children of the Hebrews (Antiphon 1) Palm Sunday Procession

Psalm 24 (23)

- (1) The Lord's is the <u>earth</u> and its fullness, \*

  It is he who <u>set</u> it on the seas;\*

- (2) Who shall climb the <u>mountain</u> of the Lord?\*

  The clean of hands and pure of heart,
