

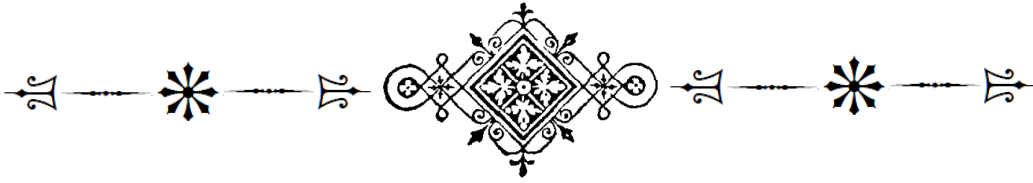

On the thirty-first of March, the holy Pasch of our Lord Jesus Christ with joy we shall celebrate.

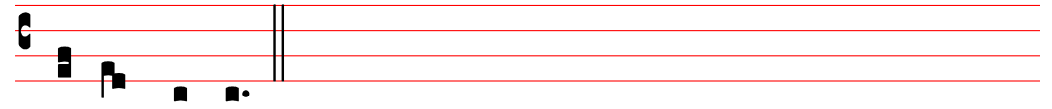
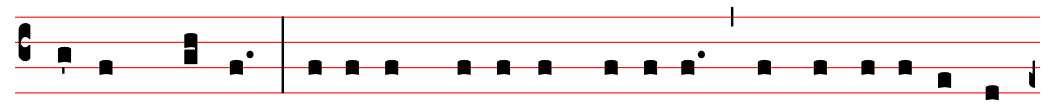
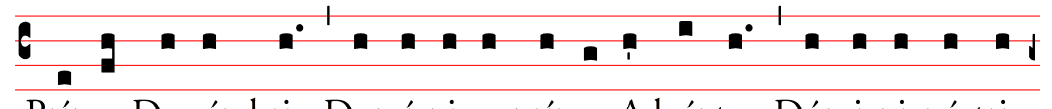
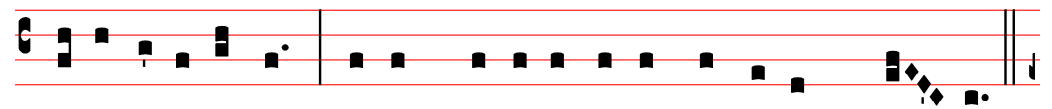
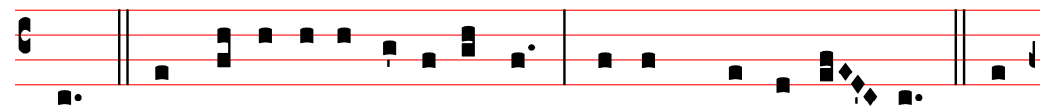
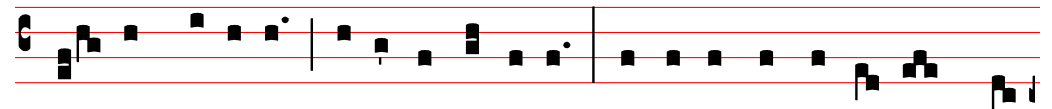
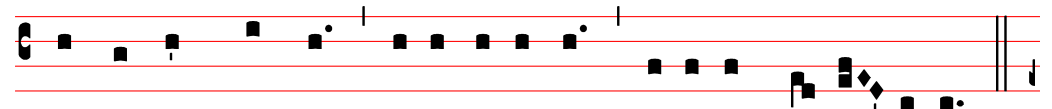
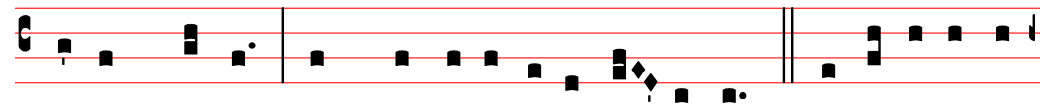
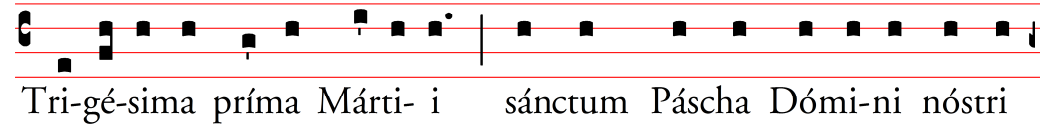
[On the second Sunday after Pasch, the diocesan Synod shall be had.]

On the thirtieth of the same month, the Feast of the Most Holy Body of Christ.

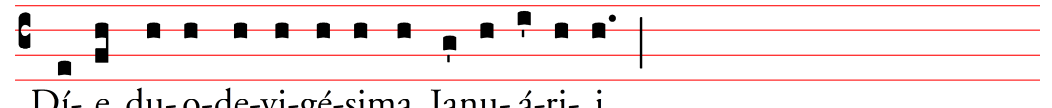
On the first of December, the first Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to Whom is honour and glory, in the ages of the ages. Amen.
