6. He vanquished the Saxons, and called the idolaters to the faith of the Father.

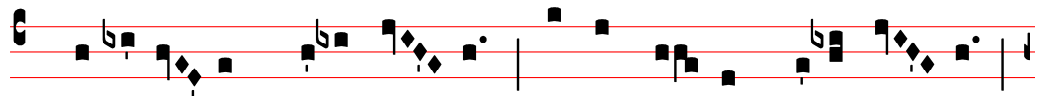
7. For the Mother of Christ he built a shrine, the throne of the kingdom, and heir in magnificence.
