- Presenting a program of Lessons and Carols near Christmastime or suitable alternative.
- Hiring orchestral instrumentalists for Christmas Midnight Masses and Easter Sunday.
- Upkeep of the Music budget, making necessary purchases.
- Upkeep and purchase of the equipment, including hymnals, books, St. Mary's choral music library, and musical instruments; also, maintenance and tuning of piano.
- Online reprint and podcasting license reporting.
- Attend a weekly meeting with the clergy and Director of Liturgy.
- Other duties as assigned.

- A love of the liturgy and music of the church as laid out by the Second Vatican Council, respecting the patrimony of the Church's musical tradition.
- Interpersonal and leadership skills are required.
- Organ and Conducing proficiency essential.

- Voice and Piano skills preferred.
