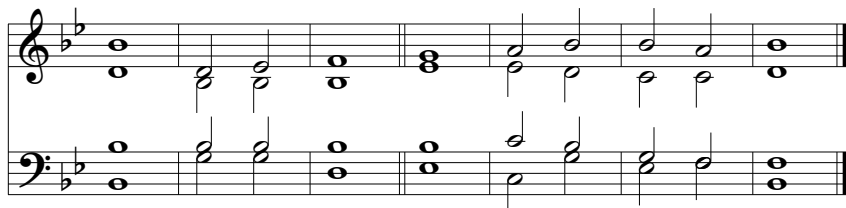

5 The noble army of Martyrs | *praise* | thee.

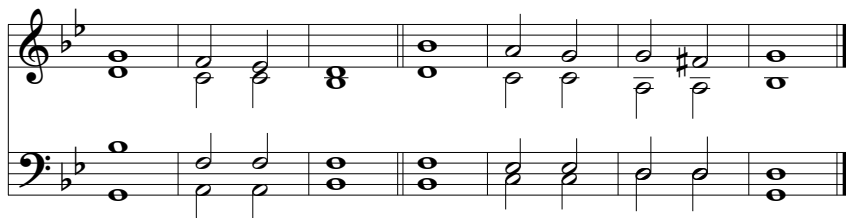

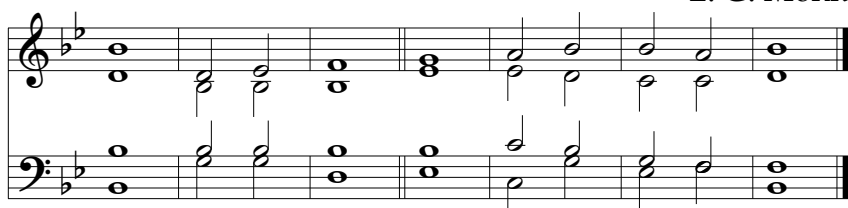
