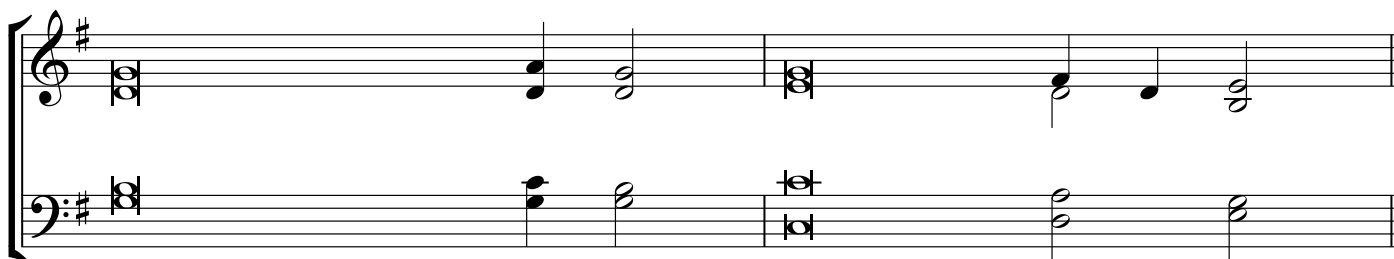
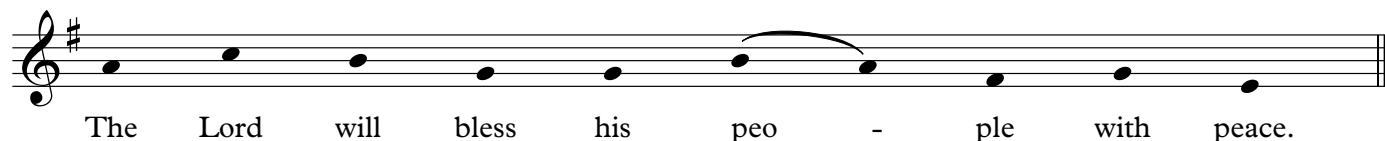
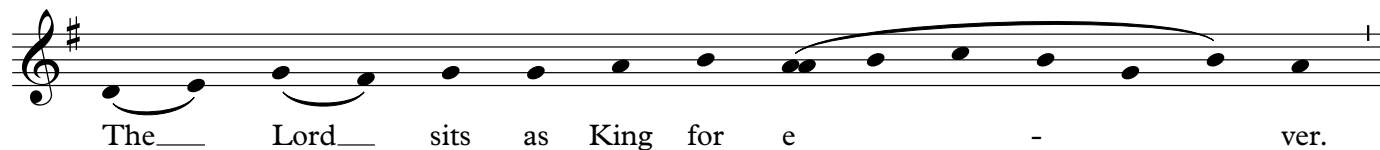

the LORD will bless his **p**eople with peace.

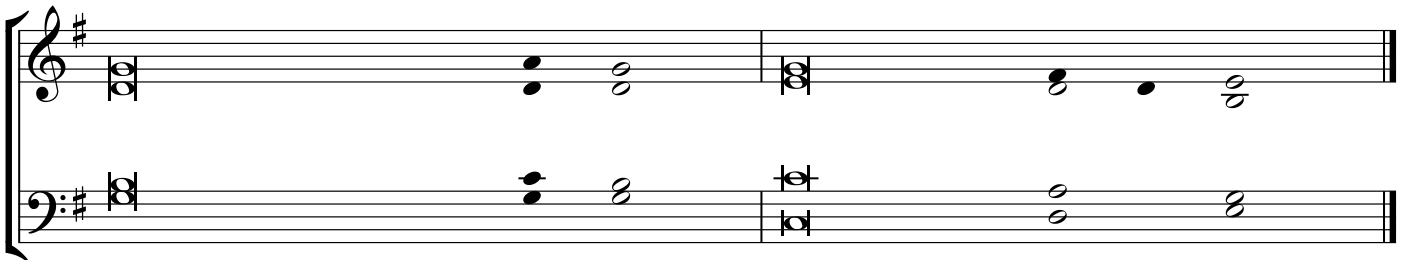
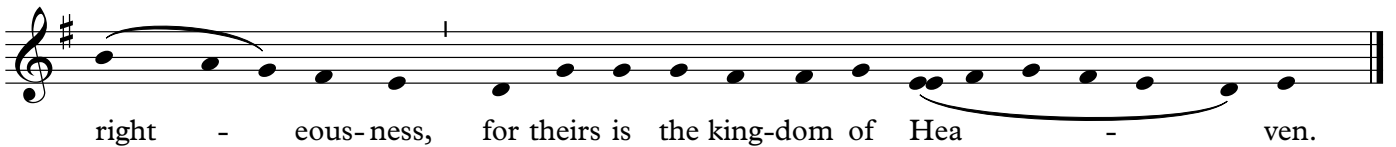
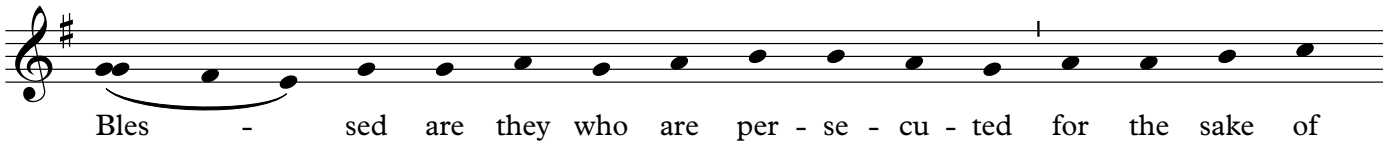
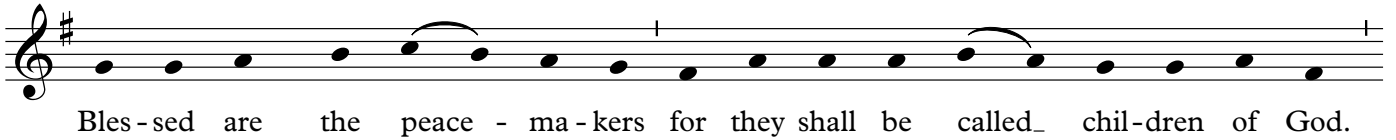
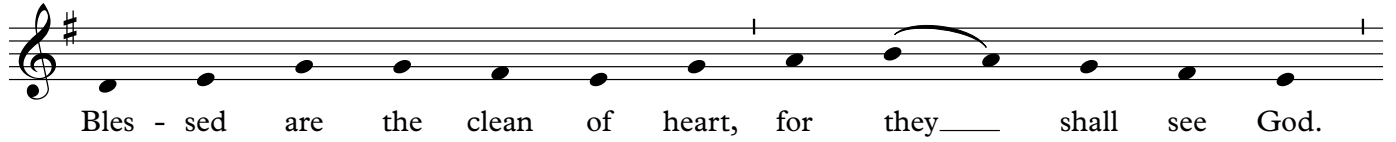

bearing **their** sheaves.

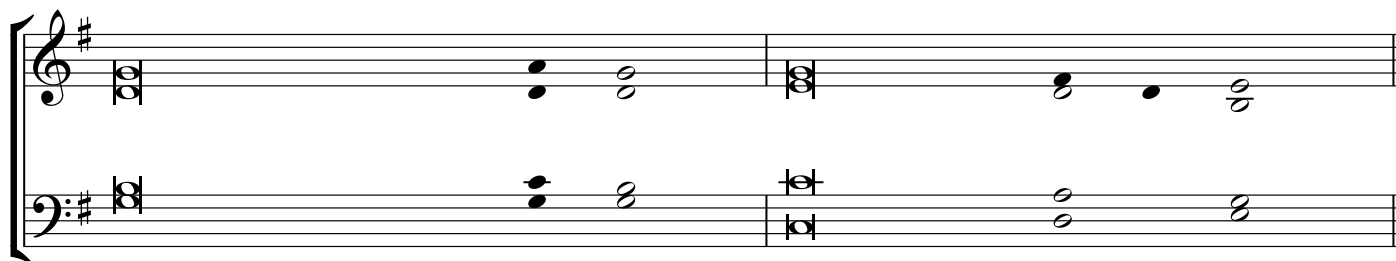
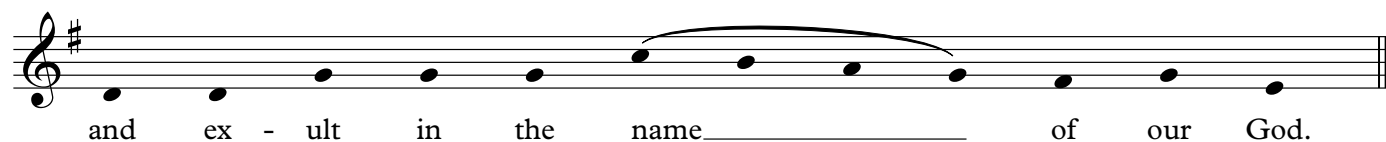
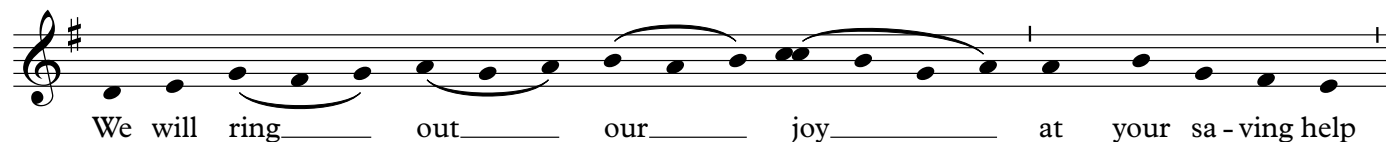

and raise banners in the name **of our** God.

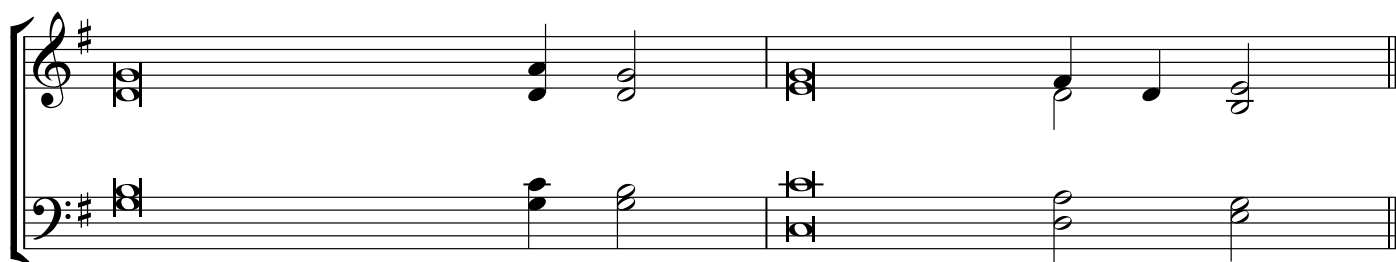
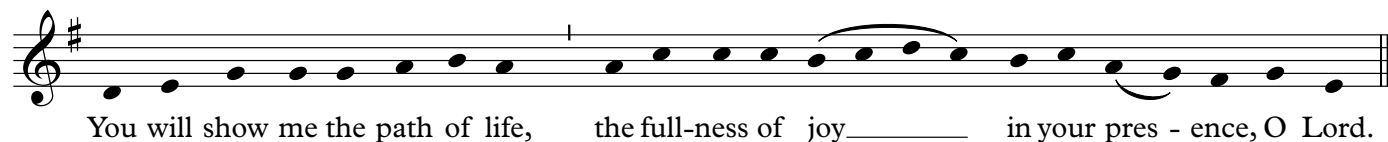

with him at my right hand, I shall **not** be moved.

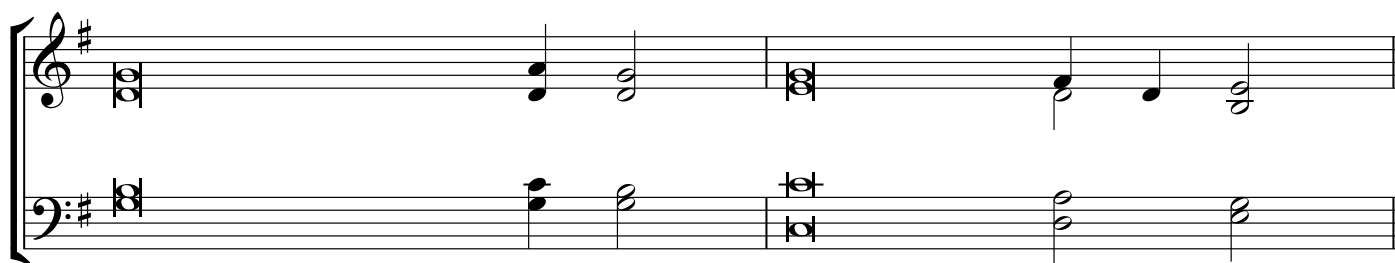
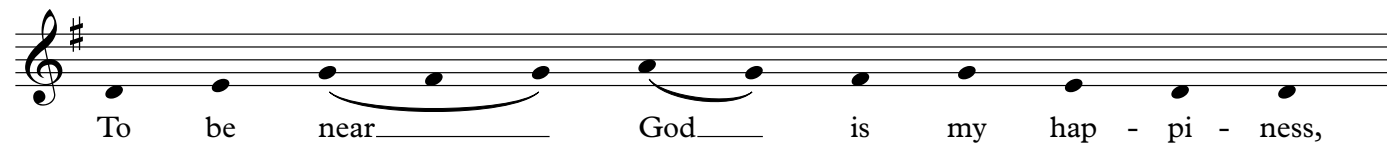

at the gates of **daughter** Sion.

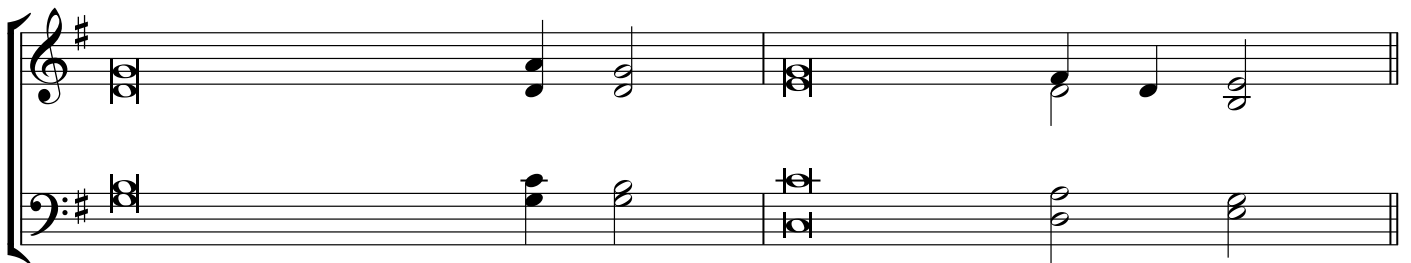
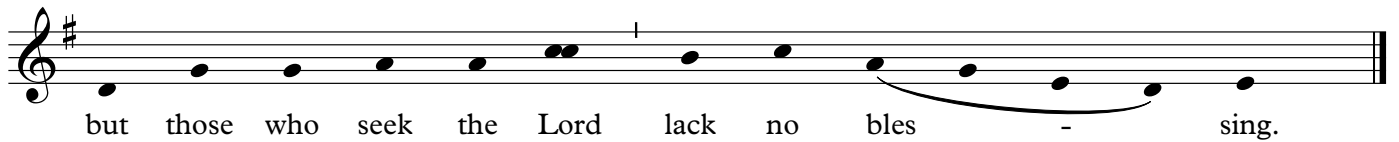
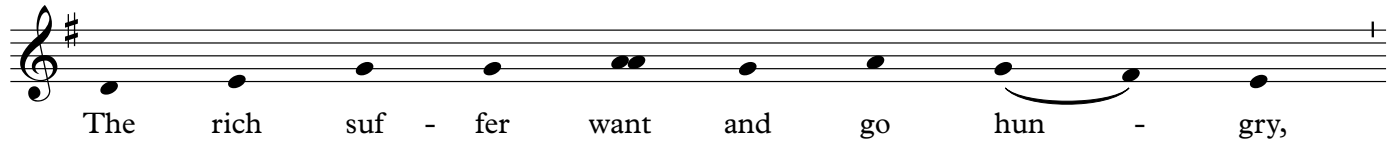

and rescued him from all **his distress**.

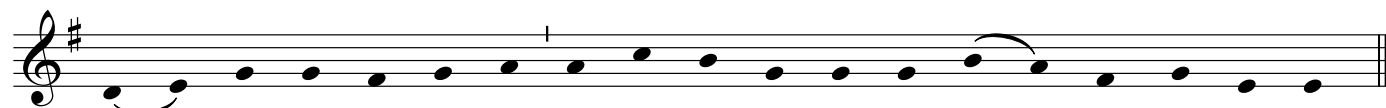

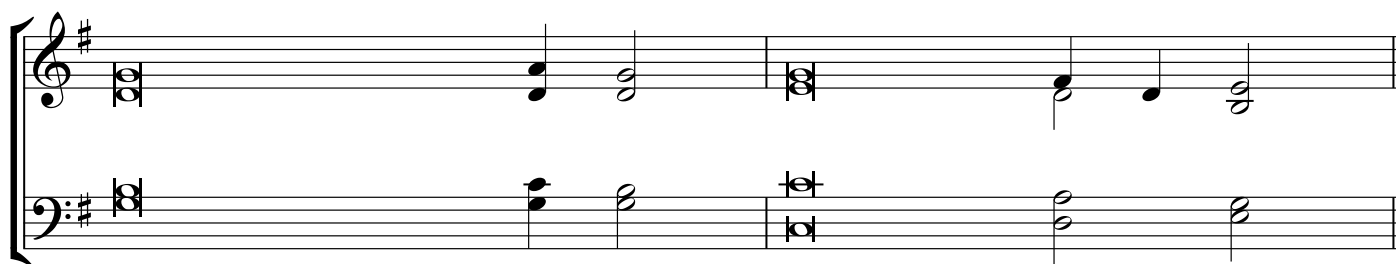

glory and blessing.

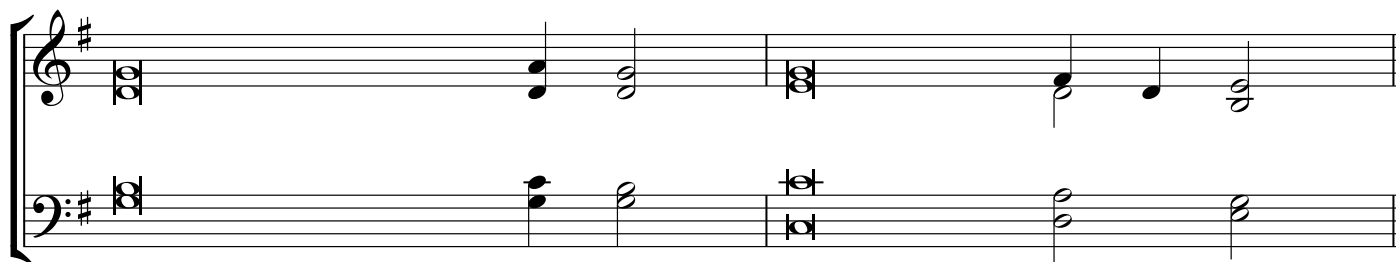
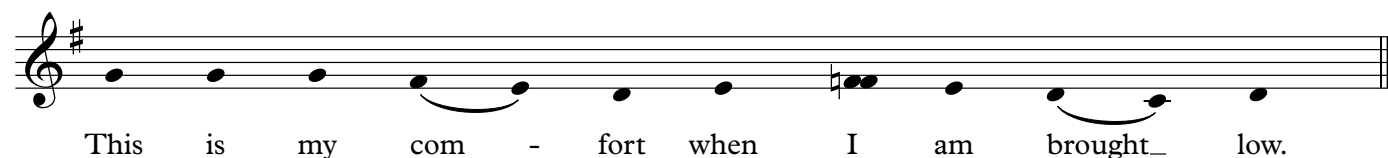
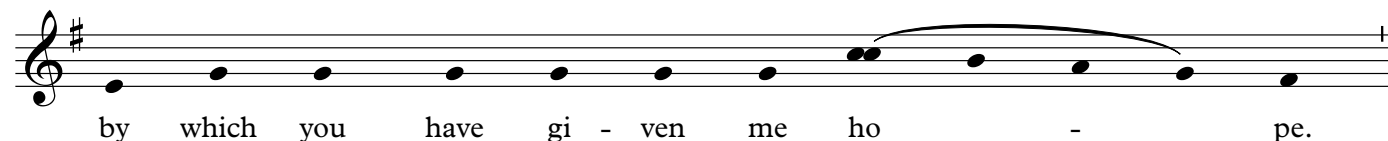
