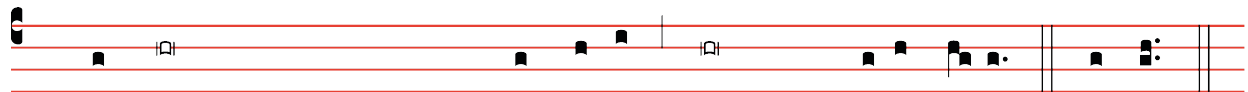

through my most grievous fault;

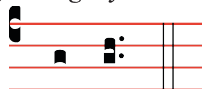
Then they continue:

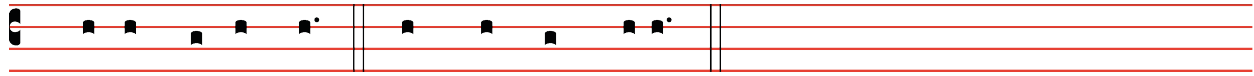

and became man.**

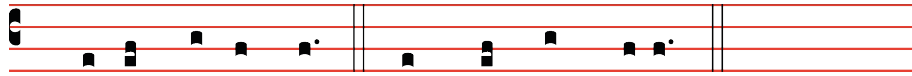
For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate,
