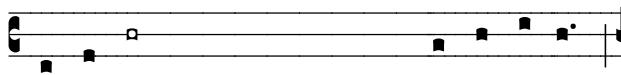


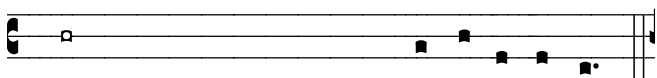
## Gradual

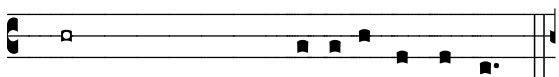
**C.** Bless- sed<sup>†</sup> are yóu, O lórd, the Gód *of* our fáthers.
