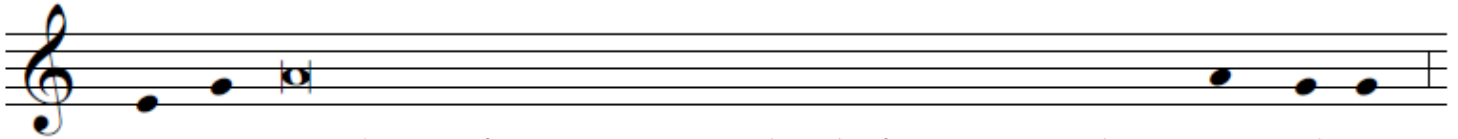


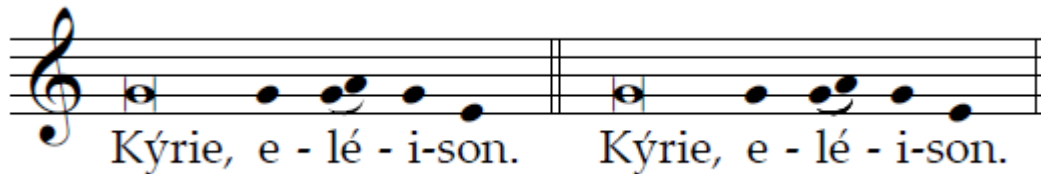
PENITENTIAL ACT FOR THE CLOSING OF THE YEAR OF MERCY

After a brief period of silence, the Deacon, or another minister sings the following invocations:

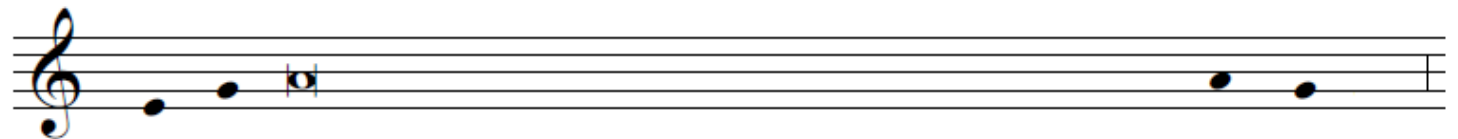

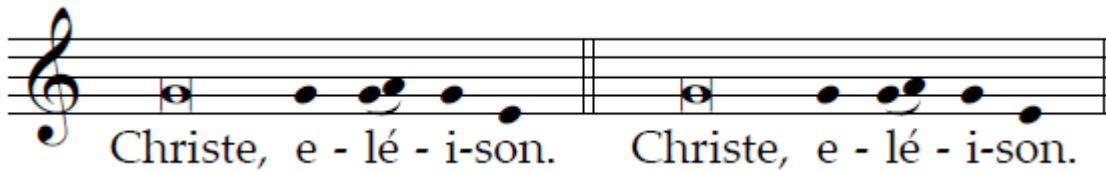
You command us to forgive one another before approaching your al-tar:



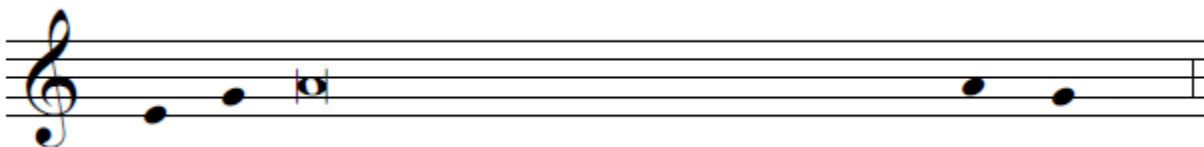

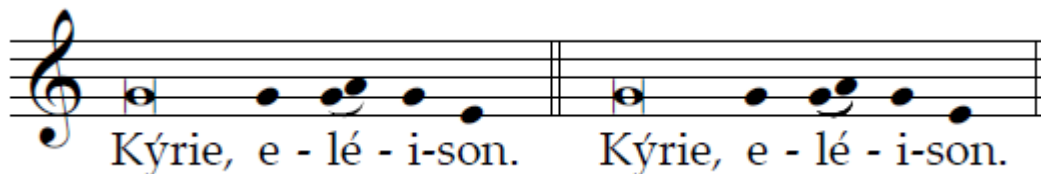
You in- voked mercy upon sinners as you hung upon the cross:



Christe, e - lé - i-son. Christe, e - lé - i-son.

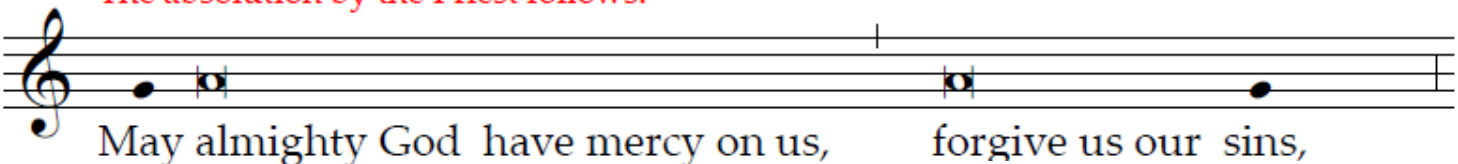


You en-trust the ministry of reconciliation to your Church:



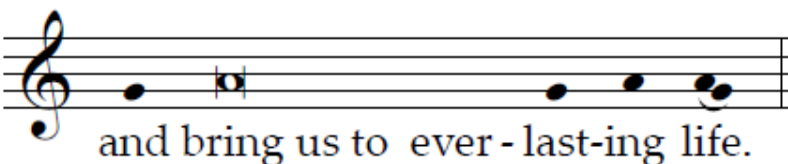
Kýrie, e - lé - i-son. Kýrie, e - lé - i-son.
