PSALMODY

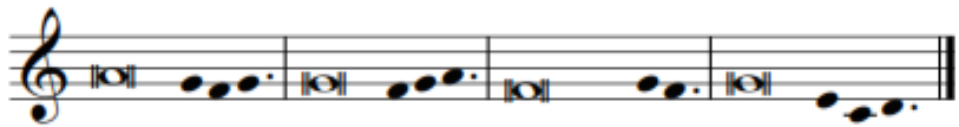
Ant. 1 ¹Christ our Lord is a **priest** for ever, ⁴like Melchizedek of old, **alleluia**.

Advent II Sunday ¹Rejoice always! I say it again. Rejoice! Everyone should see how unselfish you are. The Lord is near.

Epiphany Three mysteries mark this holy day: today the star leads the Magi to the infant Christ; today water is changed into wine for the wedding feast; to-day Christ will be baptized by John in the river Jordan to bring us to salvation.

Lent Sunday II Our Lord Jesus Christ abolished death, ⁴and through the gospel he revealed eternal life.

Palm Sunday With palms welcome the Lord **as** he comes, ²with songs and hymns let us **run** to meet him, ³as we offer our **worship** and sing: ⁴Blessed be **the** Lord.

Solemnity of St. Joseph ¹Jacob became the father of Joseph, the husband of Mary. ⁴She gave birth to Jesus who **is** called Christ.

Easter Sixth Sunday As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; live on in my love, alleluia.

OT 2 A Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world.

B The disciples came to see where Jesus lived, and all that day they stayed with him.

C There was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and Jesus was there with Mary his mother.

Our Father...

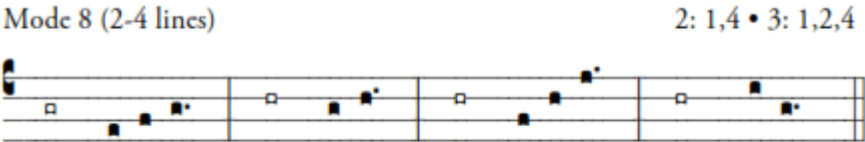
Ant. 2 ¹God dwells in **highest** heaven; ⁴he has the power to do all he wills, **alleluia**.

but the earth he has given **to** men

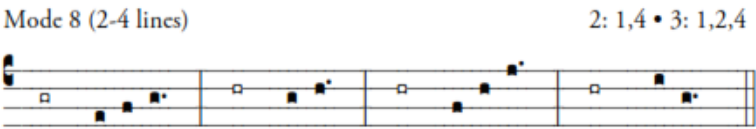
The dead shall not **praise** the Lord,
