

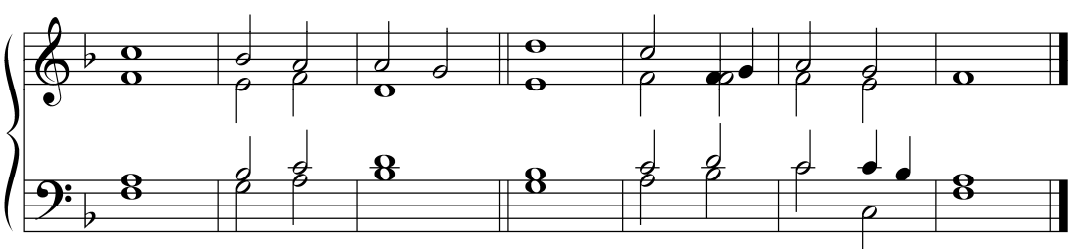
Propers for *Corpus Christi*
Gregorian Psalm Tones / Anglican Chant

Legend: Syllables positioned under eighth notes are sung either one per note or one to a group barred together. Syllables positioned under a double whole note (totally variable in performed length) are sung according to speech rhythm until the next cadence. The small eighth note is only sung when there is an *italicized* syllable positioned under it. The bar-line | is a breaking point during a reciting note where a break is observed and a ‘short’ breath may be taken. The repeat of the Antiphon may be performed on the prescribed reciting note (as below) or simply repeat the first line of chant.
