
## Psalm for the Christ the King Year A (Psalm 23)

You have prepared a ban**quet** for me in the sight **of** my foes.


My head you have anointed **with** oil; my cup is **o**verflowing.


Surely goodness and kindness shall **foll**ow me all the days **of** my life.
