




1. Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your Name give Glo-ry;

5. They have mouths, but they can-not speak; eyes have they, but they can-not see;


6. They have ears, but they can - not hear; noses, but they can - not smell.

9. O Israel, trust in the Lord; he is their help and their shield.






