GENERAL PRINCIPLES FOR CHOOSING MUSIC

Propers

For principles regarding the source of the antiphons, see the previous page.

Explanatory Note: *Lumen Christi Missal*

Antiphons in this collection are assigned to a liturgical period/commons by the editor. However, when an antiphon's text is identical or substantially similar to a text assigned in the Roman Missal or *Graduale Romanum*, the classification of the official source takes precedence over the editor's grouping in the *Lumen Christi Missal*. This is especially relevant to the Offertory antiphons. Ritual, institutional, and certain seasonal Masses may depart from these norms when the character of the celebration warrants it.

Hymns

Office As assigned in the *Divine Office Hymnal*

Mass Chosen based on the text's relevance to the readings and other proper texts of the given liturgy. On feasts when Vespers is recited privately, its proper hymn may be sung at Mass, so that the community may encounter the feast's proper sung hymnody. Preference among chant-based (non-proper) hymns is given to those included in Pope Paul VI's hymnal *Jubilare Deo*.

Order of Preference among Commons for Choosing Antiphons

When no proper antiphon is assigned and a saint belongs to more than one applicable Common, the following order of preference is used. This order is informed by the traditional arrangement of the saints, expressed most clearly in the Litany of the Saints given in the *Roman Missal* on Easter Vigil:

1. Apostles and Evangelists
2. Martyrs
3. Doctors of the Church
4. Bishops
5. Priests and Abbots
6. Religious
7. Virgins
8. Holy Men and Women
