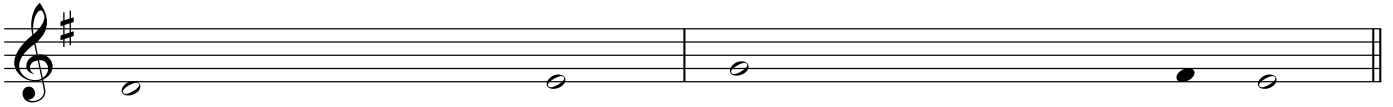

Ps 68 (67)



1. Let God arise, let his foes be **scattered** Let those who hate him flee from *his* **presence**.  
 As smoke is driven away,  
 so drive them away; †  
 like wax that melts before the **fire**, \* so the wicked shall perish  
 at the presence *of* **God**.
2. But the just shall rejoice  
 at the presence of **God**; they shall exult with glad *re - joicing*  
 O sing to God;  
 make music to his name. †  
 Extol the One who rides on the **clouds**. The LORD is his name; exult at *his* **presence**.
3. Father of orphans, defender of **widows**: \* such is a God in his ho - *ly* **place**.
