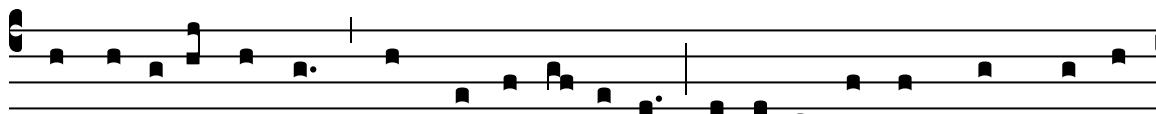


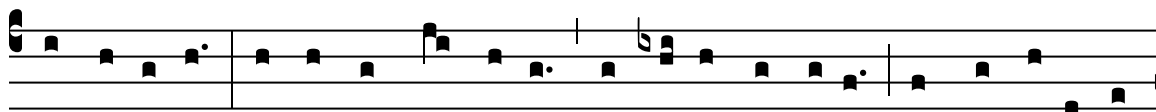
O God of Loveliness

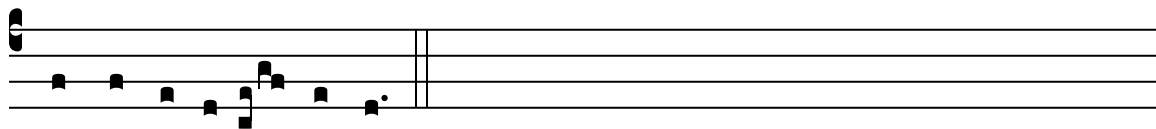
