

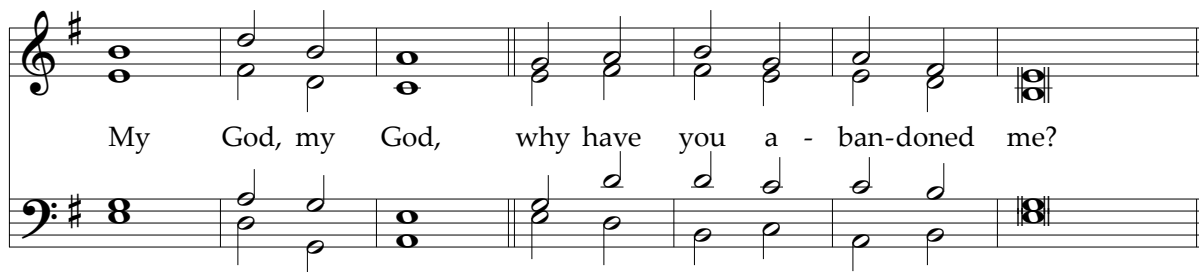

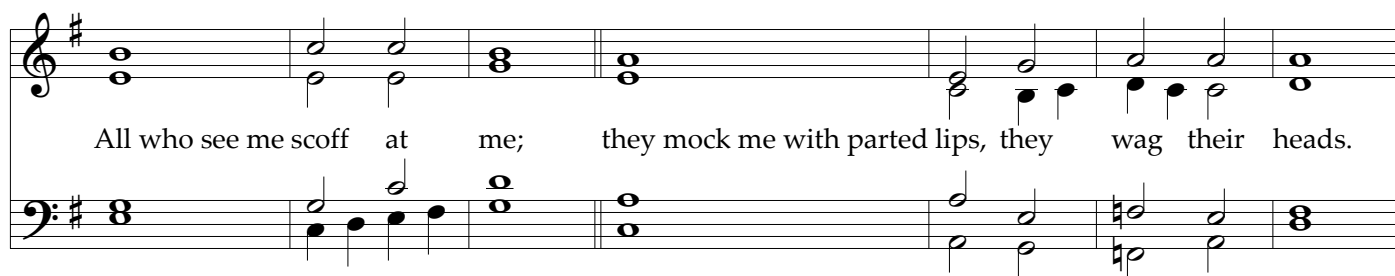

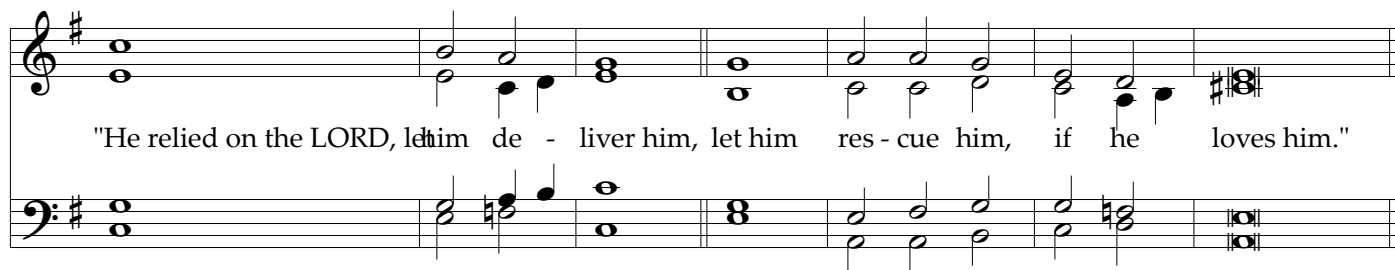


My God, my God, why have you a - ban-doned me?

Verse 1

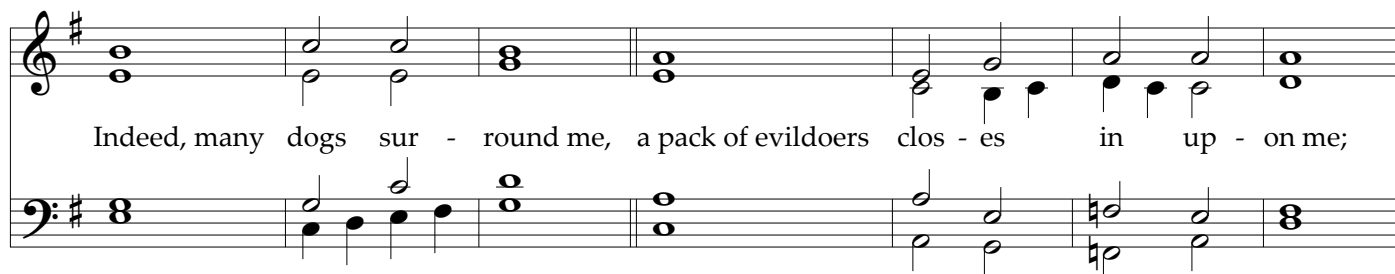


All who see me scoff at me; they mock me with parted lips, they wag their heads.
