Historically it's the 7th and final short chanted prayer service at the end of the Monastic day; a quiet good night to God. Lent is the 40 day season of preparation and interior reflection before the celebrations of Easter. Compline enhances that preparation. The only illumination is a 94 candle array in the Nave to enhance the ambience. There is no accompaniment, save some wayward hand bells. All music is appropriate for Lent; echoes from centuries past with a variety of harmonized music and an abundance of plainsong and Gregorian chant. There is no sermon; no offering; little participation; only quiet reflection and the choir projecting its sonic imprint from the loft. Join us during this humble season and bring a friend.
