The Communion Song for the Anniversary of the Bishop is *The Lord has put his servant*, **454**.

The Entrance Song is *I am the good shepherd*, **158**, but during the Lenten season it is sung thus:

During the Easter season, end the Preparation and Communion antiphons with the *alleluias* found on p. 378.

For Peace and Justice

The Entrance Song is *Give peace, O Lord*, **269**.

The Responsorial Psalm is *To you, O Lord*, **214**.

The Alleluia Psalm is *In you, O Lord*, **243**.

The Preparation Song is *Do not abandon me*, **253**.

The Communion Song is *O Give us, Lord*, **59**.

During the Easter season, end the processional antiphons with the *alleluias* found on p. 378.
