

Cantor 1:	I will give you glory, O God, my King, *
Side 1:	I will bless your name <i>for</i> ever.
Side 2:	I will bless you day after <i>day</i> * and praise your name <i>for</i> ever. The Lord is great, highly to be <i>praised</i> , * his greatness cannot <i>be</i> measured.
Side 1:	Age to age shall proclaim your <i>works</i> , * shall declare <i>your</i> mighty deeds, shall speak of your splendour and <i>glo</i> -ry, * tell the tale of your won- <i>der</i> -ful works.
Side 2:	They will speak of your terrible <i>deeds</i> , * recount your great- <i>ness</i> and might. They will recall your abundant <i>good</i> -ness; * age to age shall ring out <i>your</i> justice.

Side 1:	To make known to men your mighty <i>deeds</i> * and the glorious splendour <i>of</i> your reign. Yours is an everlasting <i>king</i> -dom; * your rule lasts <i>from</i> age to age.

- **Cantor 2:** *The Lord* is faithful in all his *words* *
- Side 2: and loving *in* all his deeds. The Lord supports all who *fall* * and raises all who *are* bowed down.
- Side 1: The eyes of all creatures look to *you* * and you give them their food *in* due time. You open wide your *hand*, * grant the desires *of* all who live.
- Side 2: The Lord is just in all his ways * and loving *in* all <u>his deeds</u>.
 He is close to all who *call* him, * who call on him *from* their hearts.
- Side 1: He grants the desires of those who *fear* him, * he hears the cry and *he* saves them.
 The Lord protects all who *love* him; * but the wicked he will utter-*ly* destroy.
- Side 2: Let me speak the praise of the *Lord*, † Let all mankind bless his holy *name* * for ever, for ages *un*-ending.

henceforth all ages will call me blessed.
- Side 2: The Almighty works marvels for *me*. * [---] *Ho*-ly his name! His mercy is from age to *age*, * on *those* who fear him.
- Side 1:He puts forth his arm in strength *
and scatters the proud-hearted.
He casts the mighty from their thrones *
and rais-es the lowly.
- Side 2: He fills the starving with good *things*, * sends the rich *a*-way empty.
- Side 1: He protects Israel, his *ser*-vant, * remember-*ing* his mercy, the mercy promised to our *fa*-thers, * to Abraham and his *sons* for ever.
- Side 2: Glory be to the Father and to the *Son* * and to the *Ho*-ly Spirit
- Side 1: as it was in the beginning, is now and ever *shall* be * word *with*-out end. Amen.
