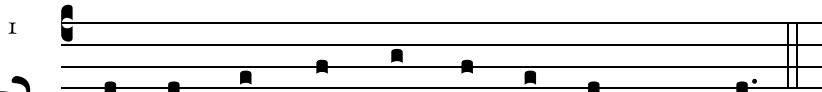


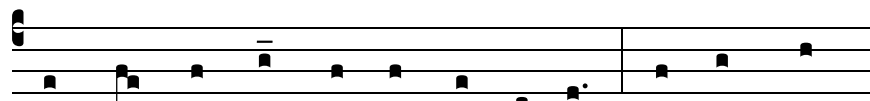

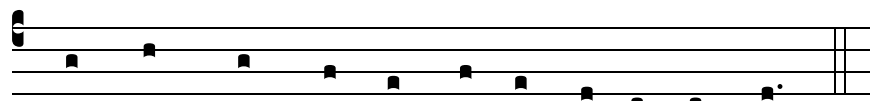
**R.** O bless the Lord, my soul, O bless the Lord.



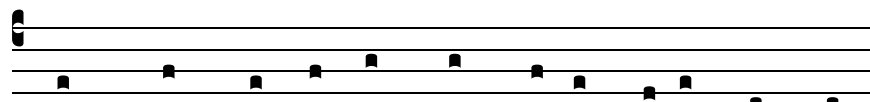
1. O Lord, my God, you are great indeed! You are clothed



with majesty and glory, robed in light as with a cloak.



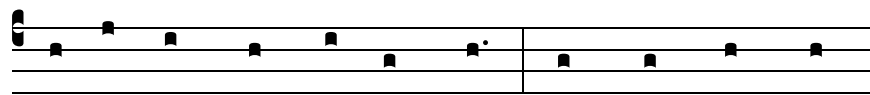
You have spread out the heavens like a tent-cloth. **R.**



2. You have constructed your palace upon the wat-



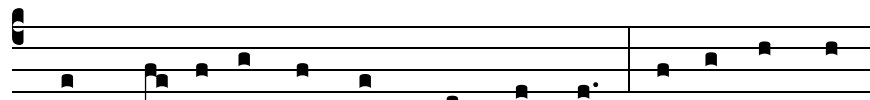
ers. You make the clouds your char-i-ot; you trav-

your messengers, and flaming fire your ministers. **R.**



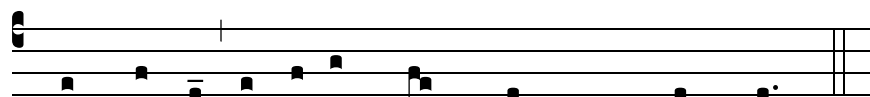
3. How man-i-fold are your works, O Lord! In wisdom you



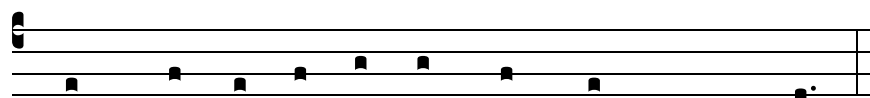
have wrought them all, the earth is full of your creatures;



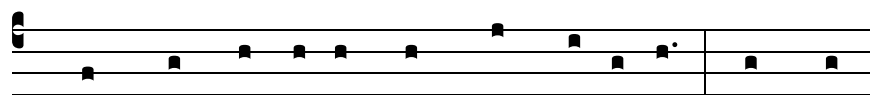
the sea also, great and wide, in which are schools with-



out number of living things both small and great. R̄.



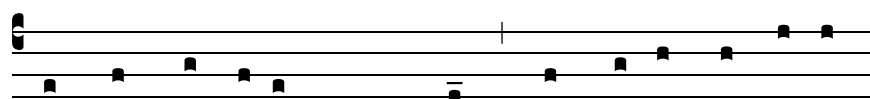
4. They look to you to give them food in due time.



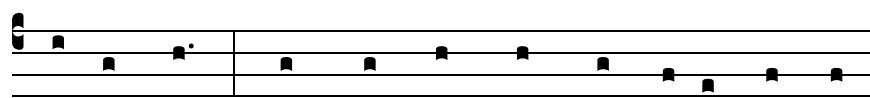
When you give it to them, they gather it; when you



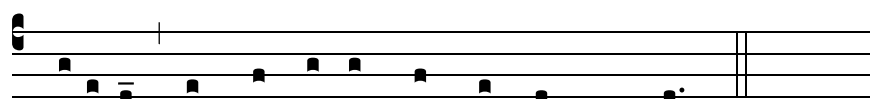
open your hand, they are filled with good things. R̄.
