

The Church of the Assumption in the Germantown neighborhood of Nashville, Tennessee seeks to build its parish choir, the *Cantores Sanctæ Mariæ Magdalænæ*, for the upcoming 2026–2027 choral year.

We are looking for Catholic volunteers for all voice parts.

Student choristers (16 years and up), college students, and young graduates are very welcome to sing. Local choral directors, please feel free to share this opportunity with interested students and singers.

Rehearsals are on Wednesdays beginning August 5 from 7–9 PM. Ordinarily, we sing for the high Mass on Sundays at 10 AM (9 AM warm-up) as well as occasional weeknight services at 6 PM (warm-up no later than 5 PM), and for the Sacred Triduum. A complete service calendar is available.

Our repertoire centers on Gregorian chant and Renaissance polyphony as well as the best of English hymnody and more modern works.

Strong music-reading skills are essential, and singers should be comfortable adapting their vocal technique to the linear character of chant and polyphony. Fluent chant notation skills are not required.
