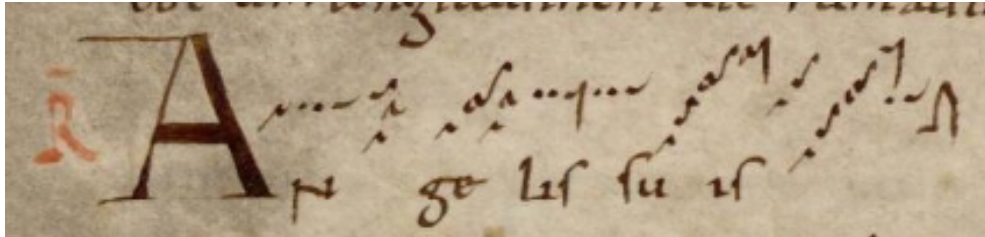

I assume that they are more or less in order of importance, since Laon 239 is listed first, and there is a whole other page proclaiming the importance of Laon 239.

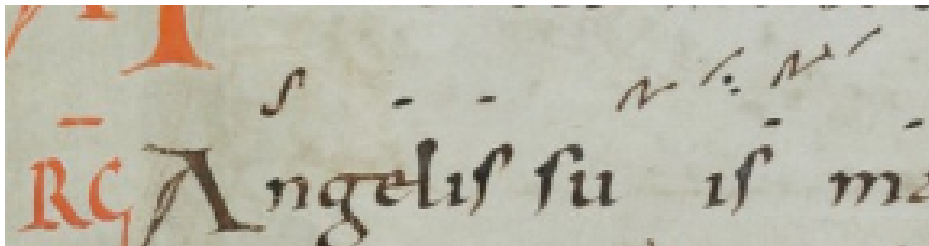

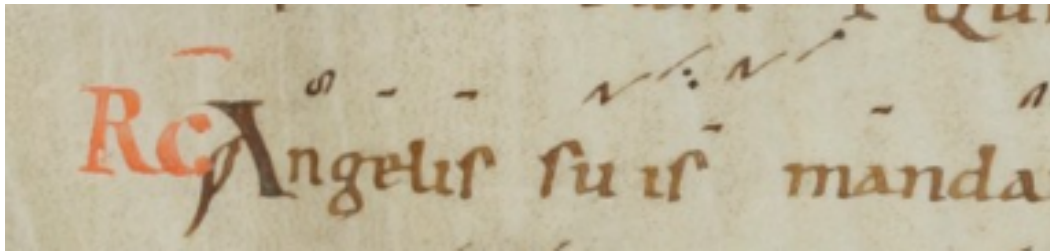


