




TIMELESS MUSIC

The Sacred Choral Program presents a vibrant and rewarding musical experience for professionals and beginners alike. Students will be steeped in Gregorian chant and Polyphony and become familiar with the rich liturgical tradition of church choral music through the works of great composers such as Mozart, Vivaldi and Schubert. This resident program offers students private vocal lessons and opportunities for a variety of choral experiences. Advanced singers will study conducting techniques and perform solo portions of the repertoire.

PHILOSOPHY

Unique to Living Water, the choral program contains an academic component which complements the practical training and informs each singer's understanding of music. Classes in the liberal arts of music will be held daily, emphasizing the power and objective beauty of music.

COMMUNITY

Students will enjoy a strong and welcoming community, participate in morning and evening prayer, and have daily opportunity to attend Mass. Personal time in the rural beauty surrounding the college promises refreshment during this unique experience of music.



MAESTRO UWE LIEFLANDER (Fine Arts Instructor) has had over 3 decades of experience in musical pedagogy and performance as an instrumentalist and choral conductor. He studied at Regensburg Akademie für Kirchenmusik (Academy for Church Music) and at the Royal Conservatory of Music, University of Toronto, in the Orchestral Training Program. During this time, he was particularly drawn to the study of organ music, singing, composition, and choral conducting. He is currently the head of the music department at Our Lady Seat of Wisdom Academy and is Music Director of the Sacred Music Society. Uwe has composed numerous motets and has put music to psalms in the interest of making liturgical music more beautiful and engaging. This is his second year instructing at Living Water College.



ALEXANDER MCCUNE (Program Assistant) has spent his life immersed in music. From the age of 6, he pursued this interest both instrumentally and vocally, learning piano and pipe organ and singing with the Edmonton Youth Choir under conductor, Dr. John Wiebe. During post-secondary training in Ontario, he studied choral and orchestral conducting with Maestro Uwe Lieflander and accompanied and sang with the Ontario Sacred Music Society. He returned to Edmonton in 2010 and now serves as Apprentice Conductor for the Alberta Youth Honour Choir. He is involved in many musical endeavours, including 4 additional choirs. This is Alex' second year assisting at Living Water College.
