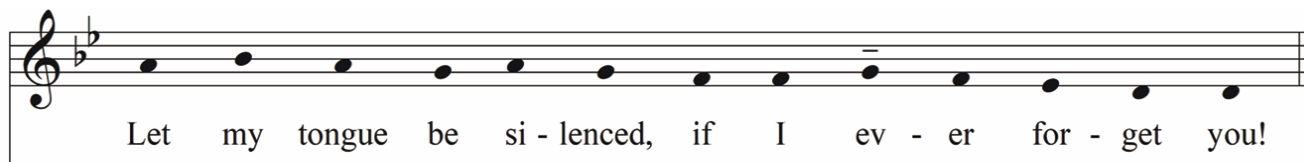


Psalm 137
