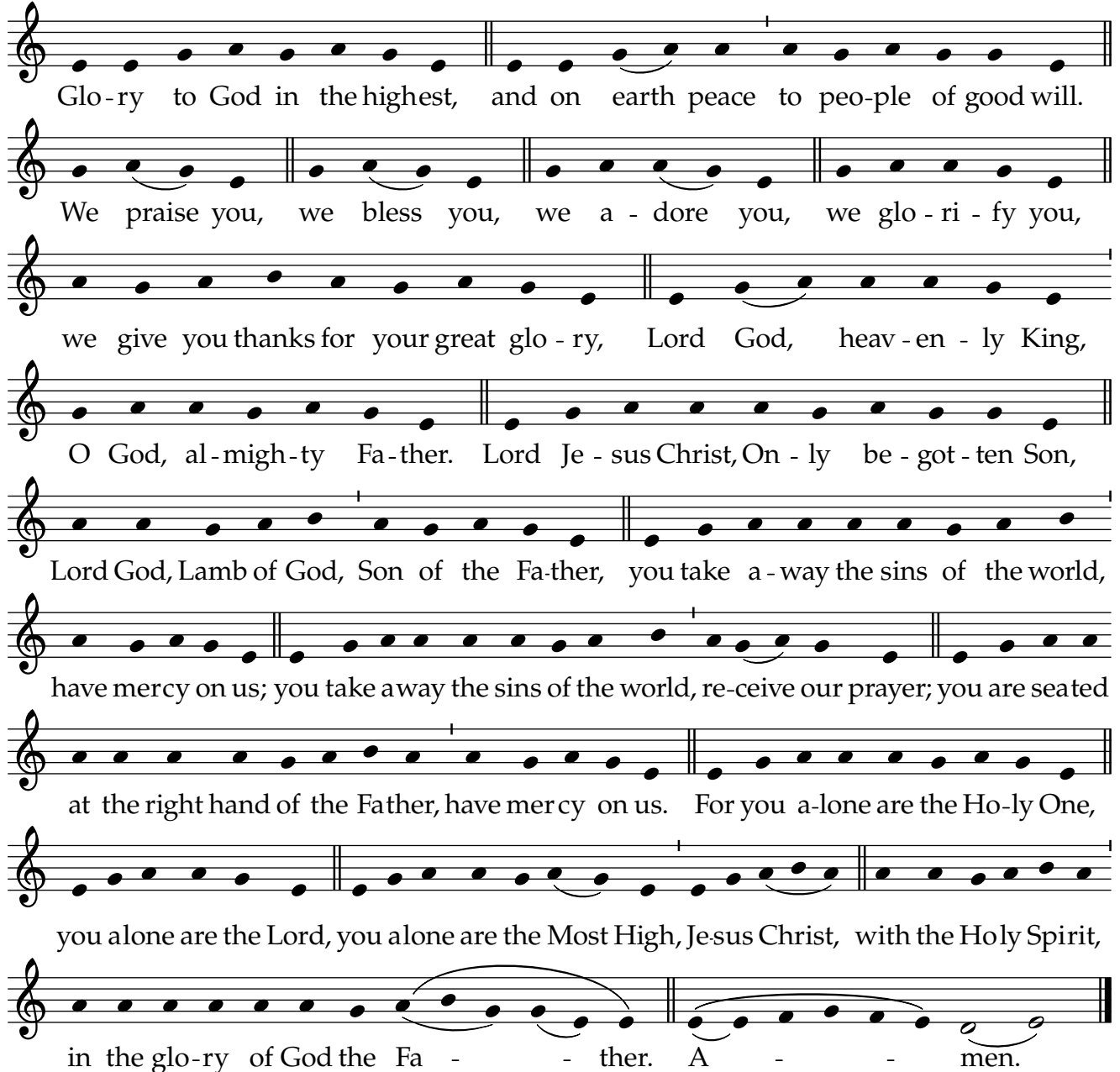

have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, re - ceive our prayer; you are seated

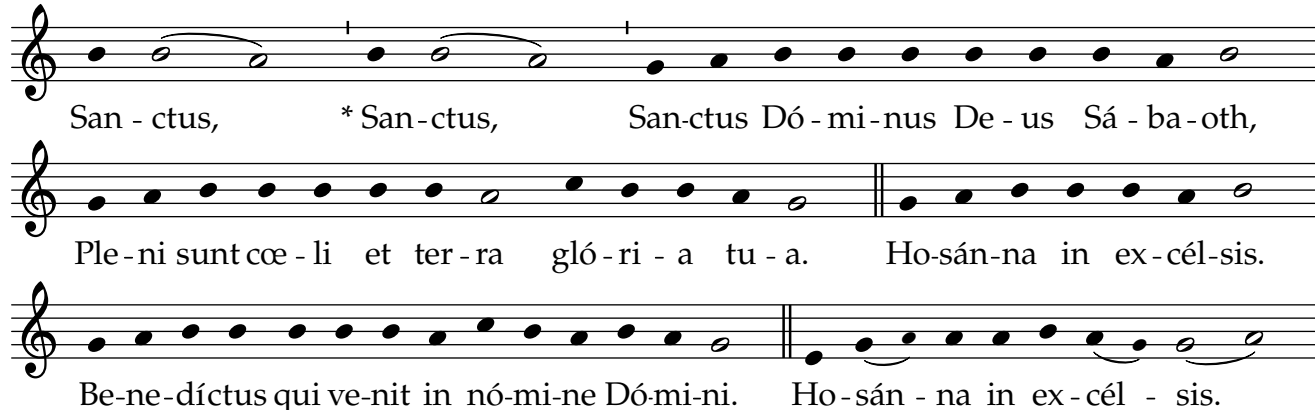

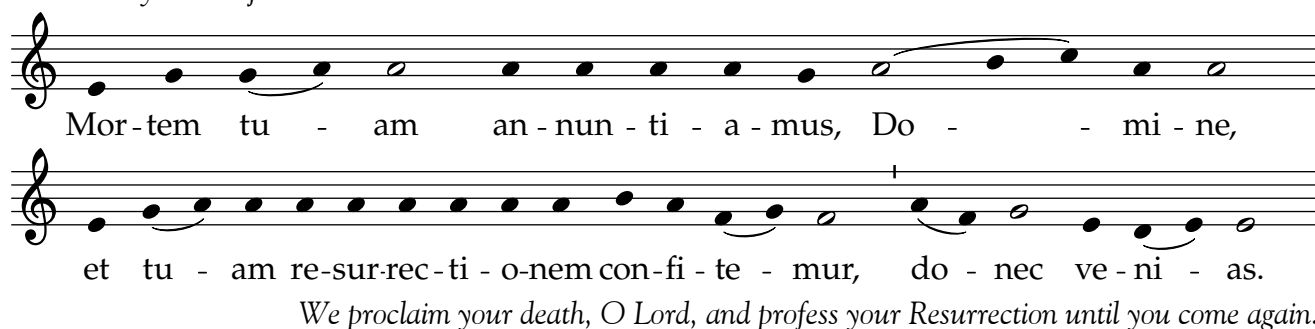
